Stewardship in Focus: Service

The Stewardship Pillar highlighted this week is **SERVICE**. If there is one pillar we should get right here in Osage County, it is this one - work is what Germans are all about! Service is your unique way to share the special talents you have that not everyone else can do. Some things our Service ministry might be doing or planning: preparing food for various functions like Confirmation, special meetings, non-fundraising fellowship activities, serving on the funeral meal prep committee, visiting the sick and homebound, coordinating transportation to medical appointments, organizing a parish medical closet (of medical supplies (crutches, scooters) all of us have at home and are not using), physical work like tree trimming, painting, construction, lawn care, gardening/landscaping, electrical, supporting the Sewing Circle, Cemetery committee, money counters after Mass, parking cars for funerals, starting a grief group or other special outreach groups, arranging outreach to parishioners who need special support and care with cards or care packages, serving on the new Buildings and grounds committee, or “Special Ops” like managing the sound system, knowing how to ring (or not ring) the church bells, sharing computer skills, doing social media, webpage creation, and other covert work! If this sounds like a way you might like to serve, then keep an eye out for this when we send the time and talent form to your email box. Or, if you are ready to sign up now you can use this QR code on your smart phone to access the form right now! Please have every member of your family who chooses to participate (especially all members who have received the Sacrament of Confirmation) fill it out individually. Paper copies will be available after masses this weekend if that is your preference.
