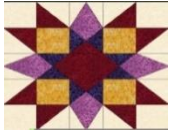

### *Sacred Heart Picnic News:*

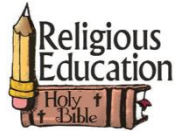
**Our picnic is fast approaching! August 11<sup>th</sup>**
