BREAKING THE SILENCE OF ABUSE

False allegations are very rare. Our initial response to someone who is disclosing abuse for the first time must be compassionate. EXTRAORDINARY MINISTERS OF HOLY **COMMUNION**

Training March 18th at 7 pm

Would you like to serve as an EMHC at Holy Mass? Do you feel called to visit the sick and bring them Holy Communion? All adult members of our Church community, please prayerfully consider serving! There will be a refresher training on being an EMHC offered in Rich Fountain Sacred Heart Church for all EMHCs on Tuesday, March 18th at 7:00 pm - this is for new and returning ministers. Topics that will be covered: how to conduct a home visit when administering Holy Communion, addressing spills or dropped hosts, what to do if a communicant does not consume the species, how to repose after Adoration. If you cannot attend, please email stewardship@sacredheartrf.com to schedule an alternative training.

"In the Diocese of Jefferson City, Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion must be commissioned every five years". The role of Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion may only be filled by those eligible and commissioned to carry it out. This includes being eighteen years old, fully initiated through Baptism, Confirmation, and the Eucharist, believing fully and entirely the Catholic faith, and living in accord with Church teaching (e.g., if married, in a marriage recognized by the Church; not publicly holding a job, role, or membership contrary to Catholic teaching or practice)."


College Scholarships Available
