The minutes from the March 3, 2025 meeting were read by Secretary Diane Rackers. A motion was made by Janie Wallace and seconded by Sarah Siegler to approve the minutes. The motion carried.

Treasurer Janie Wallace presented the financial report. Income since the March meeting totaled \$1,183.00. There were no expenses. Income included \$105 from Frankenstein Parish for tea towel fabric and the sale of one set of 7 tea towels. A motion was made by Karen Goodenough and seconded by Doris Neier to approve the financial report. The motion carried.

Correspondence:

A thank you letter was received from the Vitae Foundation thanking the sodality for the \$100 donation.

Thank you notes were received from Brynn Cramer and Erin Fick thanking the sodality for the student care packages.

A thank you note along with a check for \$200 was received from the Carl Zeilman family thanking the sodality for the funeral meal.

Old Business:

Carol Siegler reported that the tea towels still need to be hemmed. Diane reported that there are 14 sets of 7 and 35 single tea towels available for sale. Joyce Neuner reported that she has two sets of 7 tea towels and 8 singles in her booth.

Doris Frank missed sending out care packages to students this spring. She will send a military package to Jace Eisterhold.

Carol and Sarah Siegler delivered a hatchback full of donated items to the St. Raymond's Society.

The April 26-27 bakes sales coordinated by Work Group 4 made a profit of \$388.00.

Father Debo requested gifts for the 2025 graduates to be given out at the May 11 graduation mass. The sodality usually gives visor clips or rosary bracelets to the high school graduates but apparently last year Father Debo gave gifts to all the graduates. Doris Frank brought to the meeting all the visor clips, key chains and rosary bracelets from the cabinet of religious articles. There are enough to give something to all the graduates. A motion was made by Joyce Neuner and seconded by Diane Rackers to give all graduates a gift this year. Joyce Neuner will deliver the visor clips, key chains and rosary bracelets to the parish secretary Patty Phelps. Patty has an additional three visor clips in the parish office that can also be used.

Janie Wallace has talked with Shelly Zeilman about flowers for the high altars in church. They are planning to move some of the flowers from upstairs in church to the new school basement so they can get to the other flowers up there. They have not yet requested any money for the purchase of flowers. A motion was made by Diane Rackers and seconded by Joyce Neuner to provide an allowance of \$350 for purchase of flowers for the high altars in church if requested.

New Business:

Carol Siegler has received confirmation from Geralyn Kleffner for a \$150 match to the sodality from Western Catholic Union. Doris Neier received a similar confirmation for a \$150 match for the Sacred Heart Quilting Club. Doris Neier will follow up on the match from Catholic Financial Life.

New Business:

Diane Rackers, Doris Frank and Karen Goodenough volunteered to coordinate the Good Shepherd Center School's Out Collection in May. Diane has put up the post-it notes in the back of church and requested that the parish secretary send out the list of items needed with the May 10-11 bulletin.

Karen Goodenough volunteered to coordinate the Comet Caring Closet Collection in August.

Doris Neier has three sets of tea towels selected for the picnic quilt auction. Sarah Siegler added that she has a set of 7 wine tea towels done that could be included.

Liturgical assignments were made for the July 26 mass for the deceased members of the St. Anne's Sodality.
