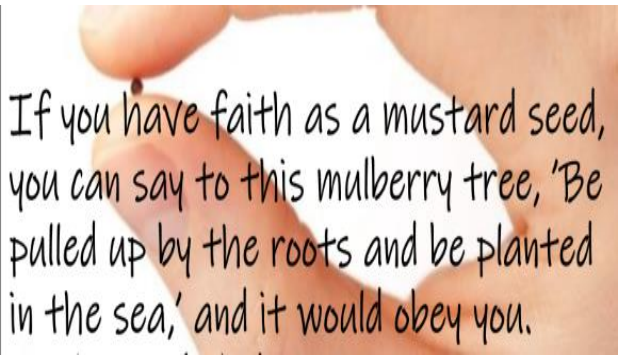

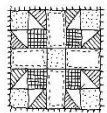
☪ The Athletic Committee will be meeting next week on Thursday, October 9th at 6:00 P.M. at Holy Family School.

This October, we will once again take an **attendance count** at all weekend Masses. This follows the directive of the Presbyteral Council, which approved a plan for counting attendance at its meeting on February 11, 2025. As noted in the minutes of that meeting:

Since our most recent attendance count spanned a full year, we will conduct the October count in both 2025 and 2026. The diocese will then resume a full 12-month count in **2027**.
