## JANUARY 18 - SANCTITY OF LIFE SUNDAY

- January 16-24, 9 Days for Life Novena (USCCB Pro-Life), [https://www.respectlife.org/9 days-signup](https://www.respectlife.org/9-days-signup)
- January 22, Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children/Roe v. Wade Anniversary- Please pray especially on this day for the ending of abortion and especially the protection of all Missouri babies and the return of common sense regulations. Update: A year ago, after a slim passage of a pro-abortion amendment to the Missouri Constitution in November, many of us feared that thousands of abortions would be committed in Missouri. But praise God, state officials now report 80 outpatient abortions performed in Missouri in St Louis, Kansas City, and Columbia Planned Parenthoods in the first 10 months of 2025. Columbia Planned Parenthood aborted 37 of these precious lives. On January 1, 2026, the Planned Parenthood in Rolla closed, making it the first abortion referral facility to be closed this year. The court case to determine whether to empower non-physicians to perform abortion surgeries and give dangerous abortion pills to women and girls with no health department oversight. This trial begins January 12. Please pray for wisdom and strength for Peter Donohue, Deputy Director of Special Litigation, who will be fighting to uphold life for a trial that will last 3 weeks in Kansas City. The 40 Days for Life prayer campaign will begin on Ash Wednesday in Columbia, and all are invited to pray with us. False allegations are very rare. Our initial response to someone who is disclosing abuse for the first time must be compassionate.
