SACRED HEART PARISHIONERS:

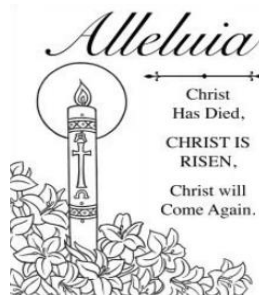
